Tasting Notes: Margarett's Cabernet Sauvignon exudes seductive aromas of dark berries, cedar and vanilla. The palate displays flavors of black cherry, chocolate covered dried cherries, anise and a mild black pepper spice. The finish is very balanced with just enough acidity and mild toasty oak flavor to pair with your favorite burger or a lovely marbled grilled steak.
